General Description

The colloquium addresses anyone writing a qualifying thesis at the Department of Philosophy (MA, PhD or Habilitation). The thesis need not be supervised by Prof. Glock. The colloquium provides an opportunity to discuss parts of work in progress. In case some available slots cannot be filled, there is also the option of discussing other material.

Texts to be discussed are uploaded by **Monday morning** ahead of the session on OLAT (under „Materialien“). The language of discussion is determined by that of the text (*cuius textus, eius lingua*). A debriefing will take place asap after the session, preferably on the basis of a revised version in which changes have been marked.

- The presented texts contain a maximum of **8'000** words. For longer texts, please indicate those parts which are most important.
- Please prepare a handout or a short presentation for your opening talk (10-20').
- Please choose the subject "VK TP Glock" for all e-mails concerning the colloquium.
